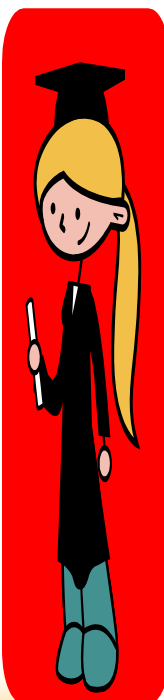

## ***LEADERSHIP DISTINCTION PROGRAM***

Opened to all students in **Certificate/Diploma, Associate's, Bachelor's and Master's Degrees**



### **REQUIREMENTS:**

Students must participate in required number of leadership seminars based on the length of their program and required number of community service projects:

**Associate program:** 8 leadership seminars; 2 community service projects\*

**Bachelor program:** 10 leadership seminars; 4 community service projects\*

**Master program:** 8 leadership seminars; 2 community service projects\*

\*Community Service Projects: minimum 4 hours = 1 service project.

Upon completion of the program, the student will receive:
