




Step 1: Open up a browser and navigate to <https://login.microsoftonline.com>






Step 6: In this example we chose to configure security questions (This section is personal preference). Click 'save answers'




Step 7: You may chose to setup the remaining 2 methods of authentication or click the 'finish' button
