Fort Lauderdale, FL—July 18, 2013— Keiser University (KU) has been recognized by The College Database as one of the colleges in Florida with the best student-faculty ratio. The website set out to find the post-secondary institutions in Florida with enrollments exceeding 5,000 students, but with less than 20 students per faculty member.

The methodology The College Database used to come up with their rankings included student-teacher ratio of less than 20 to 1, total enrollment exceeding 5,000 full and part-time students, accredited, degree-granting institutions and four-year colleges and universities.

"What these students often fail to realize, however, is that many larger institutions go the extra mile to maximize personal attention, maintaining smaller classrooms and fostering regular professor-student interaction."
