



## Best and the brightest gathering at Future of Florida Forum this week

Gov. Rick Scott joins prominent Florida political and business leaders to address what's next for the Sunshine State at the 2013 Future of Florida Forum.

The three-day consortium, hosted by the Florida Chamber of Commerce Foundation, will include some of the state's foremost CEOs, international policy leaders, elected officials, small business and non-profit representatives.

Each day of the Forum will focus on a separate conference — Florida Trade & Logistics Study 2.0, the 2013 Healthcare Summit and the Future of Florida Briefing.

They will all gather at the Disney Contemporary Resort in Orlando Monday through Wednesday to examine strategies that ensure the state's reputation as a leading competitor in the world marketplace.

Meetings, briefings and networking opportunities are at the top of the Forum schedule, covering vital issues such as trade, manufacturing and education, as well as the parts they play in Florida's sustainable future.

Tuesday, the Forum holds a "Future of Florida Briefing," kicked off with a speech by U.S. Sen. Marco Rubio titled "Insights from the Hill." The briefing continues by looking at STEM education, entrepreneurial and legislative trends that affect Florida's future economy and society.

Florida's political landscape will also be among the day's other topics as Justin Sayfie, government relations consultant and CEO of Sayfie Media, presents his 2013 "Disruption" Report. Joining in the political discourse will be Weatherford, Atwater and Marian Johnson, Florida Chamber's Senior Vice President of Political Strategy.

Wednesday will close the event with the Florida Chamber Board of Governors Annual Meeting, headed by Agriculture Commissioner Putnam. The panel discussion will be followed by insights from Gov. Scott, as the Chamber reviews the results of the 2013 Small Business Survey, which tracks issues and trends affecting small businesses.
