Marilyn Gonzalez, a single mother of a special needs child, earned her Associate of Science degree from KU in Radiologic Technology and will be walking to receive her Bachelor of Health Sciences degree this weekend. Gonzalez, who has already re-enrolled to get her Master of Science in Education, Allied Health, Teaching and Leadership received the "Rising to New"



Heights" scholarship back in 2011. She also participated in the Leadership Distinction program and has earned three separate licenses for Radiology, CT and Mammography.
