#### MEN

Socks must be worn with shoes

#### WOMEN

No Sneakers (in Gen Eds) of any kind or color

No hoodies or sweats

No jean material of any kind or color, including slacks, shirts, jackets

No slacks (capris) above the middle of the knee when standing

No skirts higher than three inches above the knee when standing

No visible cleavage

No bare midriffs, including those that appear when sitting in chair
