Lauderdale, FL – Dec. 8, 2010 – The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools has approved Keiser University to offer, at all of its campuses, the Associate of Science in Radiation Therapy, the Bachelor of Science in Network Systems and Data Communications and the Bachelor of Science in Software Engineering.
