



- \* Every academic year (8 months; 2 semesters) you will go over a new funding plan with a Financial Aid Officer.
- \* All students must make satisfactory academic progress to continue receiving Financial Aid.

Maintain the required cumulative grade point average (2.0)

Complete the required percentage of attempted coursework

Complete their program of study within the prescribed length of time

\* Did you earn a 3.3 GPA at the end of your semester? Come see us for details on an Academic Scholarship.
