- * You want to ensure you have the 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 FAFSA applications completed.
- * Every academic year (8 months; 2 semesters) you will go over a new funding plan with a Financial Aid Officer.
- * All students must make satisfactory academic progress to continue receiving Financial Aid. Maintain the required cumulative grade point average (2.0)
 - Complete the required percentage of attempted coursework
 - Complete their program of study within the prescribed length of time
- * Did you earn a 3.3 GPA at the end of your semester? Come see us for details on an Academic Scholarship.
