More than 225 graduates are eligible to walk at graduation

The event is being held at Lee County Civic Center located at 11831 Bayshore Road in North Ft. Myers.

With a strong spirit she persevered and is currently working at Golisano Naples multispecialty office as a customer service representative. The graduates are fortunate to have Representative Ray Rodrigues, the Majority Leader of the Florida House of Representatives, as their keynote speaker. Rep. Rodrigues is a budget manager for the College of Arts and Sciences at Florida Gulf Coast University, where he is also working towards his Master's of

Public Administration. Before this current position at FGCU he worked for GE managing their U.S Import Compliance program. He also served as an appointee of Governor Jeb Bush on the Lee County Housing Authority.
