McClendon Named Sun Conference Player of the Week

Keiser Men's Basketball center, Deion McClenton was named Sun Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week. This is the first time this season that a Seahawk has claimed this honor.

McClenton led the Seahawks to a 1-1 week in Sun Conference play while racking up a pair of double-doubles. McClenton began the week by scoring 12 points and pulling down 15 rebounds in an 82-71 victory over No. 22 St. Thomas. He followed that up by putting up game-highs in scoring with 20 points and total rebounds with 16.

This season, McClenton has eight double-doubles in his nine games and also leads the country in blocks per game (2.89), defensive rebounds per game (10.44), and total rebounds per game (13.55).

McClenton and the Seahawks return to the court tonight against Trinity Baptist in a 7:00 p.m. tipoff.
