My name is Nick Priolo, and I work for Palm Beach County Therapeutic Recreation. We provide program and events for people with disabilities. One of the programs that we offer is our Progressive Golf Clinic for people with physical disabilities. This program would not be possible without Keiser University Professor, Donna White, and many of her Keiser University College of Golf and Sports Management students, who volunteer and assist Professor White with running the program.
