

KEISER UNIVERSITY AS, OTA PROGRAM OUTCOMES

The Accreditation Council of Occupational Therapy Education (ACOTE) independently accredits all OTA programs. To be eligible to sit for the National Certification Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT) examination, a candidate must evidence graduation from an accredited program.

Number Admitted: The OTA program offers admission cycles that vary by campus each calendar year, that may include January, May, and/or September. Once all general education prerequisites are completed, the program requires an additional 16-months of the program major courses for completion. The maximum number of students admitted per campus annually is seventy-two. These students then have the opportunity to become graduates in the following calendar year. The table below tracks graduates for the most-recent reporting years.

Graduation rate: The OTA program graduate cycles vary by campus that may include April, August, and/or December. This number includes students who may have failed a course but subsequently returned to complete the program and graduate within 150% of the required time. In accordance with the graduation rate calculation definition, these students are still counted as part of their original admitting cohort.
