Outcomes Table Definitions and Benchmarks

Definitions:

Graduation Rate: The percentage of students who matriculated in the first technical course in the program after the add/drop period and who complete the program. Example: 24 students start the program together and are projected to graduate together but only 22 students graduate, with 2 students failing a course. The Graduation Rate for this cohort would be determined by $22 \div 24 = 92\%$. (Reference: CAPTE PTA Annual Accreditation Report Instruction)

First-Time Licensure Exam Pass Rate: The percentage of graduates who take and successfully pass the National Physical Therapy Examination (NPTE) on the first attempt. Example: 22 graduates sit for the exam, 21 students pass the exam on the first attempt. The First-Time Pass Rate for this cohort would be determined by $21 \div 22 = 95\%$. (Reference: CAPTE PTA Standards)

Employment Rate: The percentage of graduates who sought employment that were employed (full-time or part-time) as a physical therapist assistant within 1 year following graduation. Example: 24 students graduate, 23 sought employment but only 22 found full or part-time jobs. The Employment Rate for this cohort would be determined by $22 \div 23 = 96\%$. (Reference: CAPTE PTA Standards)

Ultimate Licensure Exam Pass Rate: The percentage of graduates who take and successfully pass the National Physical Therapy Examination (NPTE) regardless of the number attempts. Example: 22 graduates sit for the exam, 21 students pass the exam on the first attempt and 1 student passes on the second attempt. The Ultimate Pass Rate for this cohort would be determined by $22 \div 22 = 100\%$. (Reference: CAPTE PTA Standards)

2-Year Average: The 2-year average for graduation rate and employment rate represents cross cohort calculations for the current and previous year based on Winter, Summer, or Fall cohort. (Reference: CAPTE PTA Annual Accreditation Report Instructions). The Ultimate Licensure Pass Rate 2-Year Average is determined by using the following formula:

$$\frac{(A * X) + (B * Y)}{(X + Y)}$$

A = ultimate pass rate of program for graduation year 2019 X = number of students in graduation year 2019 who took the NPTE

B = ultimate pass rate of program for graduation year 2020 Y = number of students in graduation year 2020 who took the NPTE

Benchmarks per CAPTE Standards (2020):

1. Graduation Rates are at least 60%, averaged over two years. If the program admits more than one cohort per year, the two-year graduation rate for each cohort must be at least 60%. When two years of data are not available, the one-year graduation rate must be sufficient to allow the program to meet the expectation for a two-year graduation rate of at least 60%. **2. Ultimate Licensure Pass Rates** are at least 85%, averaged over two years. When two years of data are not available, the one-year ultimate rate must be sufficient to allow the program to meet the expectation for an ultimate two-year licensure pass rate of at least 85%. **3. Employment Rates** are at least 90%, averaged over two years. If the program admits more than one cohort per year, the two-year employment rate for each cohort must be at least 90%. When two years of data are not available, the one-year employment rate must be sufficient to allow the program to meet the expectation for a two-year employment rate of at least 90%.
