Pg. 19, Accreditation, AS Occupational Therapy Assistant

Delete the second bullet, regarding **ACOTE/Occupational Therapy Assistant**, and add:
Keiser University's Occupational Therapy Assistant program, Daytona, Fort Myers, Jacksonville,
Melbourne, Miami, Pembroke Pines, Tallahassee, Tampa, and West Palm Beach campuses are fully
accredited by the Accreditation Council for Occupational Therapy Education (ACOTE) of the American

The occupational therapy assistant program at the Orlando Campus has been granted a status of Probationary Accreditation—Inactive by the Accreditation Council for Occupational Therapy Education (ACOTE) of the American Occupational Therapy Association (AOTA), located at 6116 Executive Boulevard, Suite 200, North Bethesda, MD 20852-4929. ACOTE's telephone number c/o AOTA is (301) 652-AOTA and its Web address is www.acoteonline.org. ACOTE's decision to grant probationary accreditation-inactive is effective as of August 2nd, 2024. On April 5, 2025, ACOTE granted a status of Probationary Accreditation—Inactive to the Fort Lauderdale Campus. This status indicates that the programs are not currently enrolling new students and do not plan to enroll new students in the future. While the programs are on Probationary Accreditation-Inactive status, the graduates of the program will be eligible to sit for the national certification examination for the occupational therapy assistant administered by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT). After successful completion of this exam, the individual will be a Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant (COTA). In addition, all states require licensure in order to practice; however, state licenses are usually based on the results of the NBCOT Certification Examination. Note that a felony conviction may affect a graduate's ability to sit for the NBCOT certification examination or attain state licensure.
