



Credit Conversion Chart

Typically, two semesters of coursework equal three quarters of coursework. This means one quarter unit has two-thirds the value of one semester hour. To convert credits, divide the number of quarter units by 1.5. For example, for a student who has earned 30 quarter units, the student has earned 20 semester hours: $30 \text{ quarter units} \div 1.5 = 20 \text{ semester hours}$.
